LAWS

Senate Bill 407

- Effective 9/11, compliance by 12-13 school year
- “child pornography”= sexually explicit image of child under 17
- Kids can be prosecuted for- receipt, possession, forwarding, production
- Juvenile conviction can result- misdemeanor or fine of 500-4,000, confinement for 6-12 months

CYBERBULLYING IS ILLEGAL IN TEXAS

Class A misdemeanor up to 3rd degree felony

Juvenile confinement 2-10 years in prison

Can result in a fine or community service

Federal law doesn't directly address this, in many cases it overlaps with discriminatory harassment

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

Anonymous apps- How would you personally use this app? What would you post anonymously? What kind of things would a person want to post anonymously? Why would you tell your secrets to strangers? If you are struggling with something, will a stranger care or be able to help you? Do you think it would be safe to accept their help/friendship?

Snapchat- Why do you want to send pictures that disappear? Would you be okay with anyone seeing that pic?

Any app- Are you being safe with that app? Are you encouraging others or tearing them down? Are you being bullied? Are you putting out too much information about yourself?

FACEBOOK



- Has several security features- restrict who views your items, can block users, can do direct messaging
- Set your security settings to block people from tagging you and non-friends from seeing your posts
- People can still find these posts- some times what you post can be shared if you don't have it marked as private
- Problems- can have multiple accounts, can be linked to other social media sites

INSTAGRAM



- Share photos and videos, can follow others; can use filters and other apps to submit pictures, must be above 13 yrs old
- Can add “geo tags” to photos, watch your security settings
- Can follow others without them following you
- Usually “public”, can set to private
- Searchable, especially with #
- If set to public, anyone can comment on pictures



TWITTER


- Can be public or private per security settings; most are public, can block users
- Searchable, especially with #
- Very widely used
- Others can retweet what you send, you can be mentioned in another tweet




SNAPCHAT




- Snaps can be caught via screen shot
- “My Story” can be set to be viewed by anyone
- Can use geo filters
- There are apps like save snap or snap save
- In settings, can have it be that you only accept incoming pics from “my friends”
- Can block users

OTHER APPS FOR YOU TO KNOW ABOUT...




YOUTUBE

Does have a safety feature called “safety mode”

Can have explicit material, personal information can be shared

Videos can go “viral” depending on the number of views



KIK



Instant messaging, uses a “user name” (instead of a phone #)
much like Instagram, sends pictures/videos/voice messages
too

Is rated 17+ in the iTunes app store


Can connect to other social media apps

Can block users and remove contacts

Anyone can send you a message if they know your user name

Can use group chat, sometimes part of bullying

Can make fake accounts



TUMBLR

Users post pictures and can post comments, can also post links to other sites, is searchable

Forums are created for specific interests, can be shared

Users can be anonymous

Can report cyberbullying, can block users or tumblelogs

There is a “safe mode” filter


IMGUR



Anonymous image sharing site, can use it to post to message boards/blogs. Popular images are featured in the searchable the gallery. Images stay as long as they get one view every 6 months.

Uploaded images not on the gallery are “private”.

They say that they monitor themselves.



REDDIT

Members can submit various content, users vote them “up” or “down”, content is divided into content areas, users can create “subreddits”

Most submissions can be posted outside of reddit, but can be called self posts,

Users can “friend” each other, users can comment

Lots of jargon

LOCATION BASED APPS



Yik Yak (uses geo fences to prevent use in area schools) all users are anonymous, students post things for others near them to read, mostly on colleges




AfterSchool- has been banned from itunes store, anonymous like Yik Yak, aimed more at teens

Streetchat- gives photo feeds of what people in a specific area want to post, anonymous, bulletin board; is limited






A social media Q&A, connects with other platforms, people create a profile and others can ask them questions. Can be anonymous. Has been linked to suicide related to bullying on the site in Britain.



WHISPER

Secret sharing app, anonymous, but
can be notified of posts near you
You can exchange messages direct
with others, kids can easily reveal
themselves to predators



OTHER APPS



Vine- Users post and watch 6 second videos



Tinder- users post pictures and “flag” someone they think is cute, if that person also “flags” them they can communicate

OTHER

Chatroulette- online chat website, pairs strangers for video chats

Omegle- similar to Chatroulette, pairs strangers for webcam chats

Foursquare- you check in and friends can see your location, can collect prizes & badges,
