

## Electronic Devices Policy

This includes: cell phones, iphones, ipods, MP3 players, CD players, game devices, electronic readers, headphones and other electronic or battery powered devices.

1. These items must be turned off and put away between **8:40 a.m. and 4:00 pm.**
2. These devices are not to be **on or used** for any reason. No calls, no ring tones, no texting, no listening, reading or playing of any kind between **8:40 am. and 4:00 pm.**
3. Violation of the above results in these items being picked up and **detention hall will be assigned.**
4. The use of cell phones, etc. to **take pictures on school property is prohibited.** Students violating this rule will **receive Saturday Detention Hall or Suspension,** and **parents** will be required to pick these items up.
5. Any use of cell phones during a **testing time will result in a "0" on the test,** assignment to Saturday Detention Hall, and a **parent** will be required to pick up the phone.
6. The use of cell phones to **call home, etc. during the day is prohibited.** Permission can be granted from the Administration, clinic and other staff members for student to use phone for such a reason if there is a specific purpose. **Failure to comply will result in two days ASD.**
7. **Detention Halls**-All types of electronic devices (cell phones, ipods, etc.) are to be **off** when students enter the Detention Hall room and remain off until the students leave the Detention Hall room.  
**\* These items are very high risk items for theft in school. Bring these items at your own risk.**

**Cameras - video or still cameras are not to be brought to campus** at any time unless permission is granted from the **appropriate AP grade-level office.** The use of camera or cell phones to take pictures or video without the **authority of the students' teacher or school administrators is prohibited.** Any use of pictures and or videos, etc. that are in violation of school rules that are placed on a social network (**You Tube, Facebook etc.**) will be subject to the student being in violation of school rules for use of such devices at school. **Any student who knowingly appears in such while at school is in violation of school rules.**

### **Expectations and Consideration:**

Students are allowed to bring electronics to school as long as they **are not on at any time from 8:40 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.** These items, including phones, are immensely popular among young people. However, due to the fact that these are high theft items on all campuses, it is highly recommended **parents/ guardians consider whether their child is mature enough to keep up with these very expensive devices.** The amount of smartphones left by users on tables, benches, and in the hallways is staggering. **These items are brought at the student's own risk and issues of electronic device will not be investigated.**
