TOUCHPAD SHORTCUTS

Command	Description of Operation		
Right-Click	Press or tap the touchpad with two fingers. You can also press Alt , then click with one finger.		
Scroll	Place two fingers on the touchpad and move them up and down to scroll vertically, or left and right to scroll horizontally.		
Move between pages	To go back to a page you were just on, swipe left with two fingers. To go forward to a page you were just on, swipe right with two fingers.		
See all open windows	Swipe up or down with three fingers.		
Switch between tabs	If there are multiple tabs open, you can swipe right and left with three fingers to quickly change between tabs.		
Drag and drop	Click and hold the item to move. While holding, move the item. Release your finger to drop the item in its new location.		

Change Touchpad Settings:

- 1. Click "Status," where the picture appears
- 2. Click Settings.
- 3. In the "Device" section, adjust the sliders to set your touchpad or mouse speed
- 4. Click Touchpad Settings to: turn tap-to-click on or off, swap your primary mouse button, choose traditional or Australian scrolling.
- 5. When finished, click **OK**.

Fix Touchpad Problems:

- If your touchpad stops working, try the following steps:
- 1. Make sure there is no dirt or dust on the touchpad.
- 2. Touch **ESC** key several times.
- 3. Drumroll your fingers on the touchpad for ten seconds.
- 4. Restart your Chromebook.
- 5. If the issue persists, contact your teacher librarian to submit a work order to LIS.
