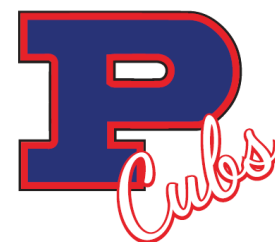


## Peet Clubs 2021-2022
