

## Ramp Up 2020

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The following information addresses student expectations while at school. Please review these guidelines with your child and make sure they understand the importance of their compliance. As always, we want to make Peet a safe place where students feel loved, accepted, and grow academically every day.

#### Arrival at School

Students will go to first period at 8:20 am. If students are going to eat breakfast, they will grab a sack breakfast and go to their first period class. They will eat the breakfast in their first period class. By doing this, this allows for greater social distancing in the mornings.

#### Prior to School

We will have a teacher at 7:45 to monitor students in the cafeteria. The cafeteria tables have “Sit Here” stickers on them. By doing this, the students know where to sit in a social distancing manner. We ask that students do not arrive early unless absolutely necessary.

#### Class Change

Peet will utilize a split bell schedule this year. The 7<sup>th</sup> graders will transition in the hallways first. The tardy bell for the 7<sup>th</sup> graders is the release bell for the 8<sup>th</sup> graders. By doing this, there will be half of the students in the hallway at one time. Classroom doors will be open so that students do not have to touch the door handle to enter the room.

For some elective classes that have both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders, this does mean that 7<sup>th</sup> graders will be lined up outside of the elective room while the 8<sup>th</sup> graders exit the room. Signage will be on the floor to prompt social distancing.

#### Lunch

The lunch tables have been labeled to tell students where to sit and in doing so, encourage social distancing. The lunches will be placed in paper bags so that students can get their lunch and go, thus reducing time in a line. In addition, students will be given student IDs that they will utilize for buying lunch and not have to touch the keypads. There will be no A La Carte lines at this time. All lines will serve traditional school lunches. Signage in the lines encourage social distancing. This year at Peet, we will have supervision for students who want to eat outside. Numbers will be limited, but there is a front patio area and the back bus ramp area will be available for students who want to go outside and have a picnic. (If students repeatedly chose this option, they might consider bringing a towel to sit on and this would also encourage social distancing.)

## Dismissal

Students will be dismissed in waves. Car rider students will be dismissed first to come to the front of the building. Please move as far up in the car rider line as possible (do not stop at the crosswalk). By stretching out the line, we can keep the line moving in a more rapid manner. Please note, only buses are allowed on the bus ramp.

Bus riders will be dismissed to the bus ramp in waves. The students will be seated on the bus according to their stop. Students with the first stops will sit at the front of the bus. Students with later stops will sit at the back of the bus. By doing this, students' movement is limited on the bus and contamination concerns are decreased.

## Hall Passes

We will use one-time use hall passes this year at Peet.

## Clinic

We will have two clinics at Peet this year. One clinic will take care of normal clinic needs. One clinic will be an isolation clinic for students that need to be picked up and recover at home.

For minor needs (bandages, daily medications...) we have a mobile clinic that will meet the student at their location.

The clinic cannot administer any medication this year that might mask the symptoms of COVID-19. Because of COVID-19, the clinic cannot give Nebulizer treatments this year.

## Masks

Masks or face shields are mandatory and must be worn in the appropriate manner.
