

FAQ's

1. What is the process for schedule changes?

If for some reason the student and parent feel a schedule change is necessary, the principal requests that the parents and the student discuss the matter with the counselors and teachers. Normally no changes will be made in a student's schedule after the first two weeks of school. Changes in Athletics for seventh grade students may be made during the first two weeks of school.

Some examples of legitimate schedule change requests for required and elective courses are provided below. Notice how these requests are handled.

For Required Courses:

In some cases students may be placed in the wrong level of a required course. Legitimate requests for course level changes are always honored.

For Elective Courses:

Elective classes cannot be changed after the first two weeks of each semester.

2. Should I choose level or honors courses?

3. What is No Pass, No Play?

"No Pass No Play" refers to policies in states that define eligibility for extracurricular activities and athletics based on academic performance, attendance and student behavior. 4. What is the difference between Athletics and PE?

Athletics is a class involving competitive sports, such as football, basketball, volleyball, and track. In order to participate, students must have a physical each year.
